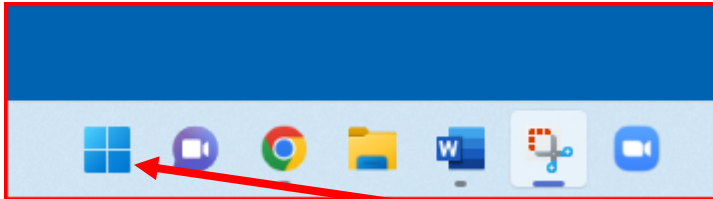

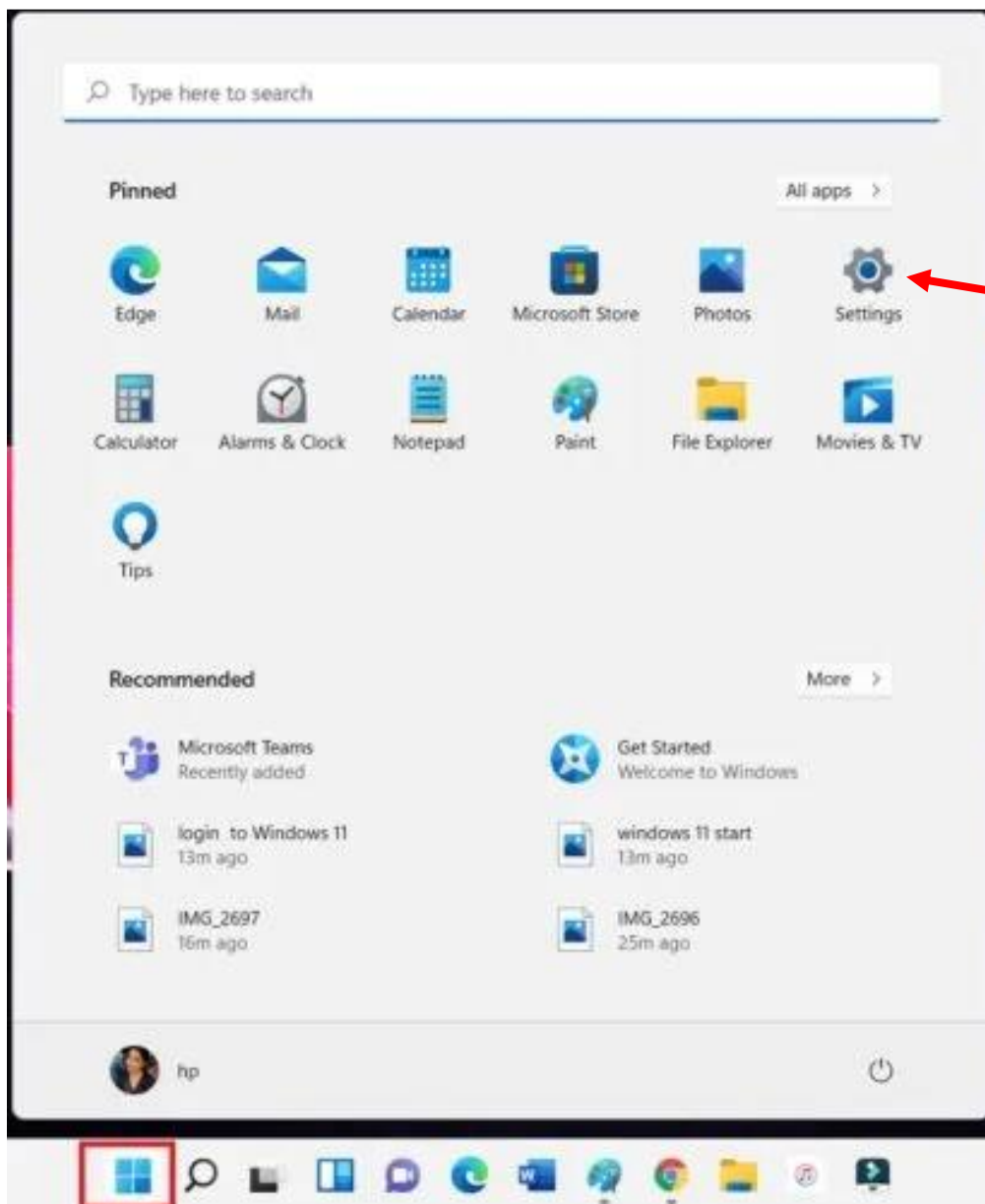

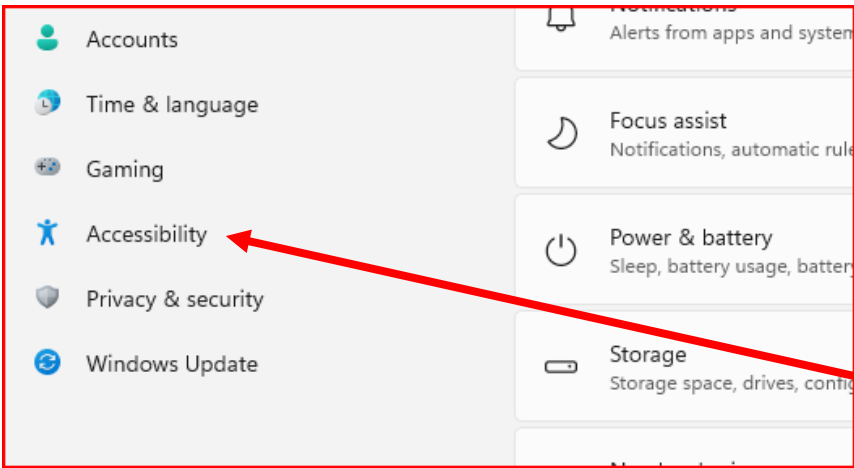
Here is how to make your Windows 11 PC more accessible



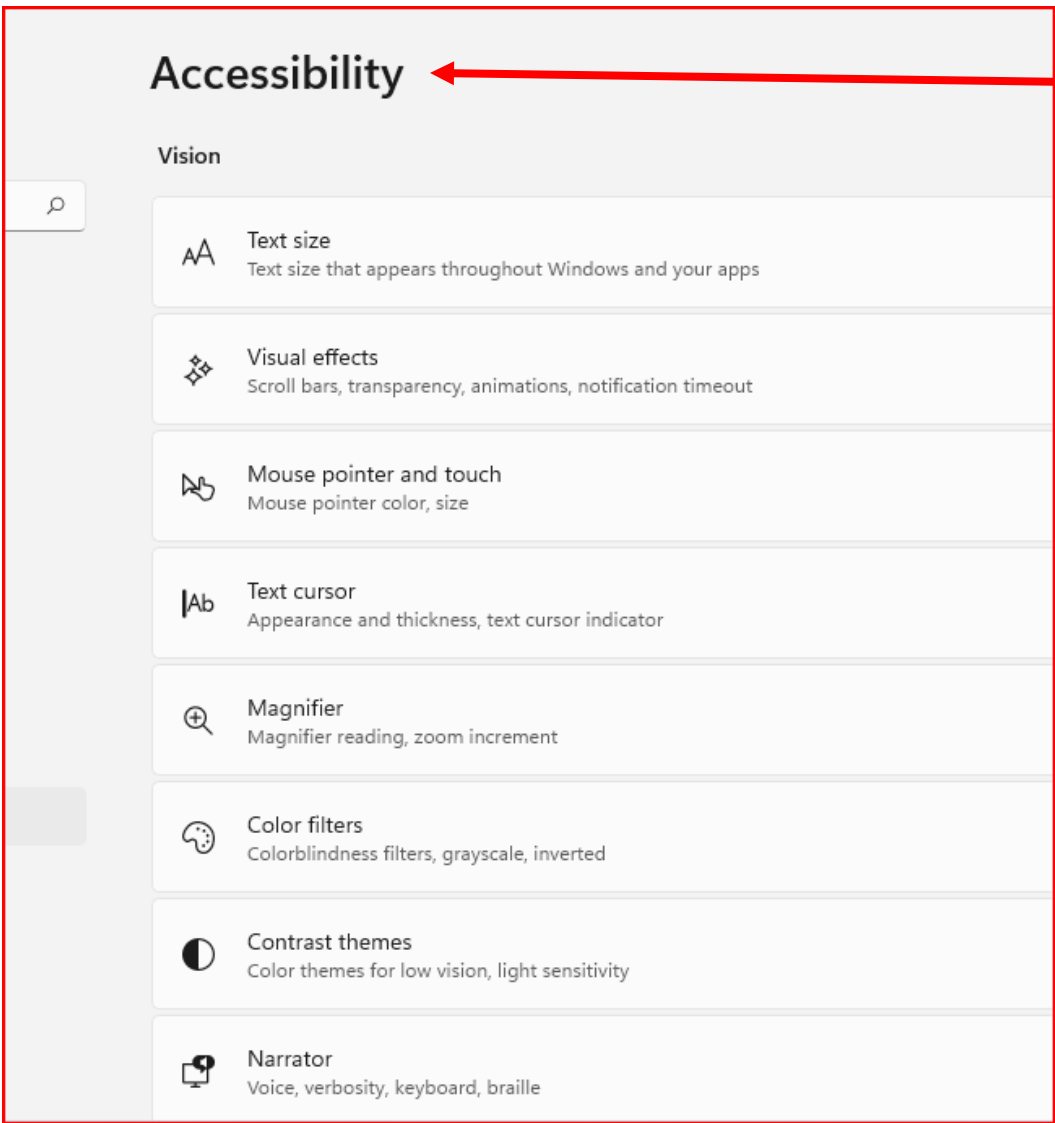
First click on the **Start Button.**

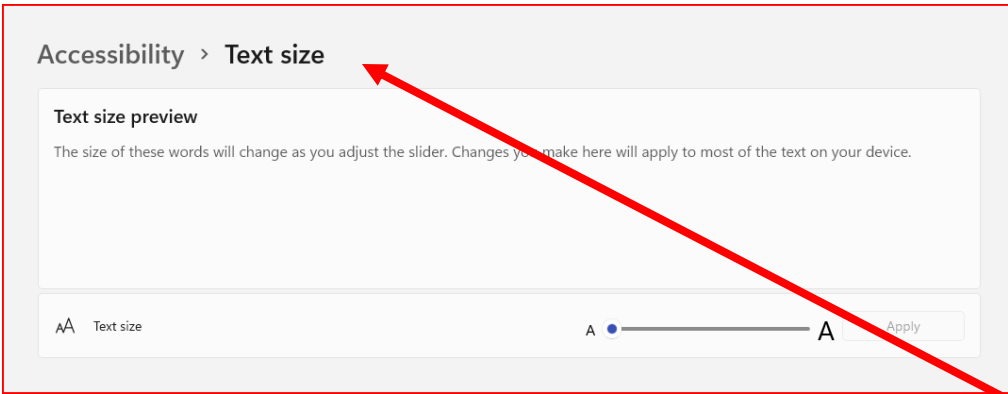


Then click on the **settings button.**



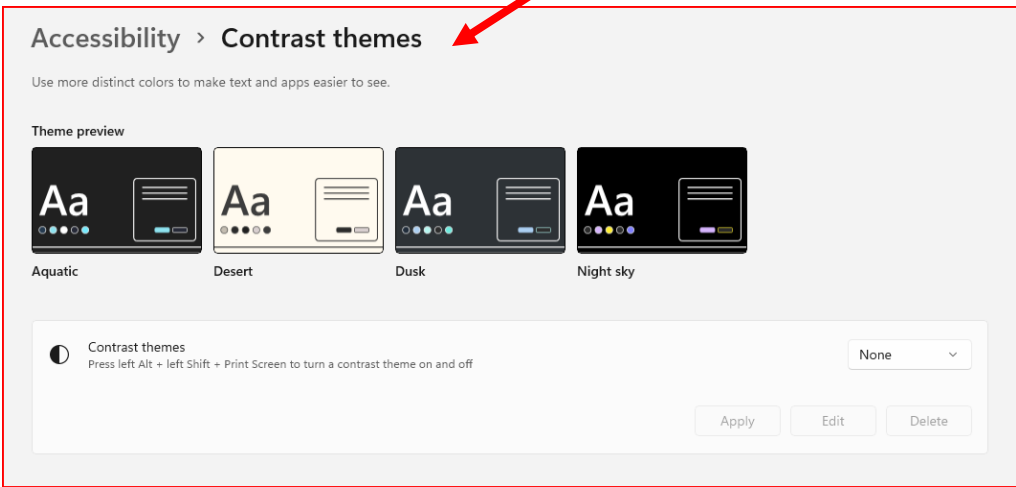
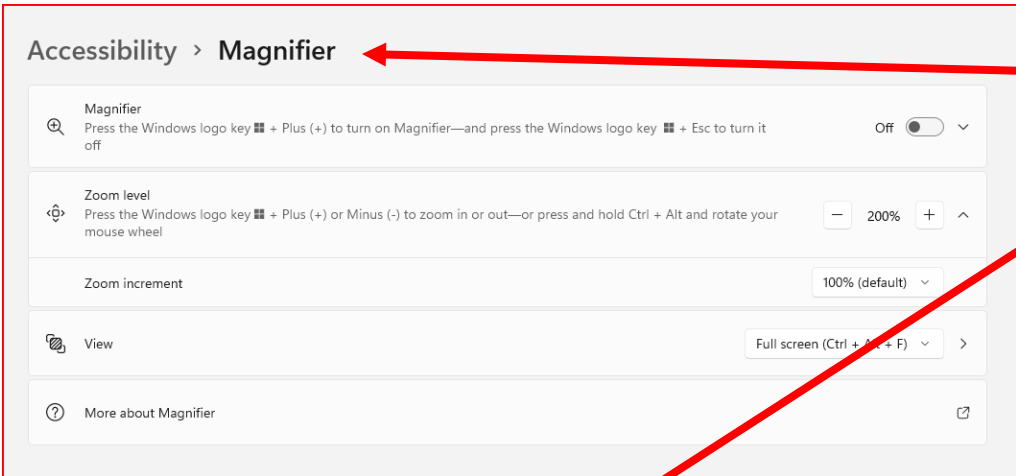
When you open settings, you will find the **Accessibility button**. Click on this button to open the **accessibility menu**.

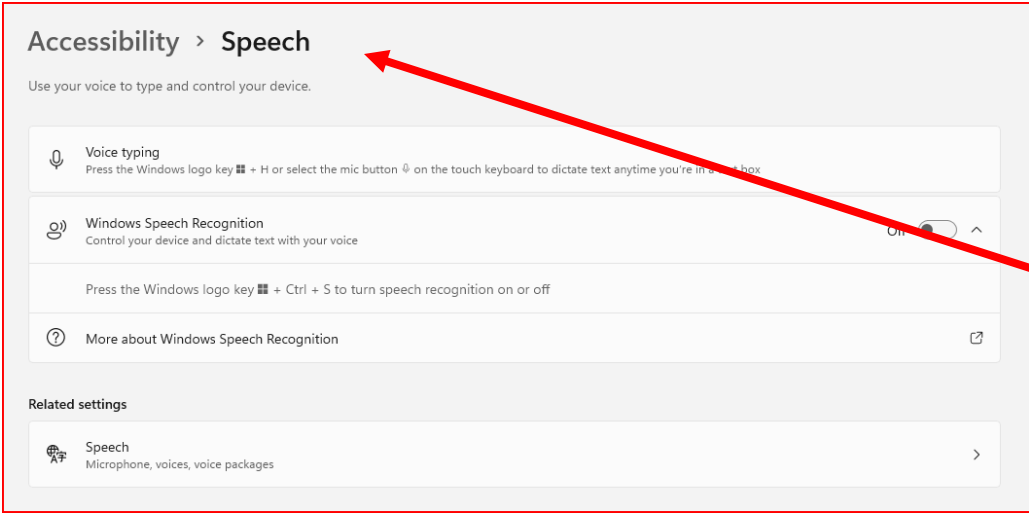




People with low vision there are a few things that they can do to the screen to help them see better such as
